

PUPIL PREMIUM PROVISION MAP 2017-2018

Pupil Premium is additional funding given to schools to support pupils who are considered to be disadvantaged.

There are several measures used to decide who meets the criteria.

The aim of the funding is to diminish differences between these vulnerable pupils and their peers.

WELLBEING

School counselling service through Younger Mind

In-house support – resilience, anger management and art therapy

In-house peer mentoring service available for all pupils in KS2

Pupil Premium mentors to ensure all pupils with this group have the support of at least one named adult in school and access to resources to help them learn

Inclusion/Nurture room – staffed daily to provide support for a whole range of different needs: academic, social, emotional, physical

Purchase of school uniform, PE equipment, stationery, etc. to raise self-esteem and reduce differences

Zumos – online mental health platform with open access for all pupils in school (currently KS3 online)

Breakfast club – invitation to all pupils who we feel would benefit from extra support to get ready for school day

Bespoke support for individual pupils – medical needs/specific specialist assessments

ACADEMIC

Small group tuition in English – reading, writing and SPaG


Small group spelling support

Purchase of Accelerated Reader and Read, Write Inc. spelling programme

Maths intervention sessions – small groups

Specially organised trips for pupils in all year groups to support careers teaching and broaden horizons/raise aspirations

ENRICHMENT

Full funding on all residential school trips in term time. Priority given to all PP pupils – Stanley Head (Y6), North Wales (Y7) and France (Y8) as well as the trips linked to curriculum areas

Funding for music lessons

Support to purchase instruments

Trips to watch theatre productions/cinema

Visiting speakers/artists/performers to enhance curriculum

Trips organised to enhance curriculum – science trip to Jaguar Landrover
